As the result of a disturbing trend of contractor fatalities, our company established a Global Contractor Safety Taskforce.

The Taskforce recognized an overall lack of data about our worldwide contractor injury experience, i.e., most sites tracked their contractor injury experience but many did not. Further, there was no worldwide roll-up of what little data was available.

In order to confirm the anecdotal view about which type of contractor activity produced the most accidents, the Taskforce recommended collecting injury & illness data separately for these three onsite contractor services groups:

### **Building, Grounds, and Equipment Maintenance.**

Contractor activities in this category include installation and maintenance of heating, ventilation, & air conditioning (HVAC) systems and equipment, electrical systems and equipment, plumbing systems and equipment, installation and maintenance of production equipment, and landscaping and grounds maintenance.

### **Administrative and Technical Services.**

Contractor activities in this category include housekeeping/janitorial duties, food service, premises security, information management, process control design and service, engineering design, and equipment and software calibration.

### **Construction Project Services.**

Contractor activities in this category include formally defined projects for the construction of new facilities or the renovation or remodeling of existing facilities that are defined in specific "scope-of-work" agreements with the contractor.
